What qualifications do I need?

You will need to demonstrate the ability to work at higher education level; 'A' Level or National Diploma. Previous experience of social care and an understanding of the nature of social work are also desirable. Acceptance on this course is conditional upon successful performance at a selection interview. You will also need GCSE English and Maths (C or above) or Key Skills Communication and Application of Number at Level 2 or above. An equivalent qualification will also be considered.

What can I do after completing this course?

You will be qualified to obtain employment as a Social Worker within the Voluntary or Statutory sectors or in field or residential settings after three years of full time study. Most students, upon completion, work within the statutory sector.

Why study this course at Kendal College?

The College's department of Health and Social Care, judged Grade 1 by Ofsted, enjoys an excellent reputation and maintains strong links with local care industries, health providers and children's centres in the area. Various grants and NHS bursaries are available.
