## What are Foundation Degrees?

Foundation Degrees enable students to gain a degree level programme that they can top up to a full honours degree with a final year at the University of Central Lancashire at Preston.

If you have A levels or a level 3 qualification such as a BTEC National Diploma or NVQ, then a Foundation Degree is a good option for you, giving you the opportunity to improve your skills, understanding and knowledge in line with employers' needs. Foundation Degrees are available part time, which usually means one evening or afternoon of taught study per week, allowing you to maintain any work and family commitments you may have.

There are a range of loans, grants and bursaries available for full and part-time study and you will only need to attend taught sessions at Kendal College for between six and nine hours per week, depending on whether you are on a full or part-time programme.
