Access to Higher Education

It's never too late! Our courses are specifically designed for adults aged 19+ and returning to study, either after a break or as part of a career change. They offer a proven and successful route on to university study. Studied two days per week over one year, you'll achieve a Level 3 qualification relevant to what you want to do, and the access student loan is written off when you complete a degree!



Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are a great way to earn and learn, with competitive wages and the opportunity to study up to Level 5 - there has never been a better time to become an apprentice! You will receive industry training and develop the skills you need to progress in your chosen career. An apprenticeship is essentially a full-time paid job with training. They are highly valued by employers, and are available at no cost to the apprentice, no matter their age.

Higher-Level Study

Making the important decision to enter into higher-level study can be life-changing, marking the start of a new chapter and possibly a new career direction. We offer full-time and part-time options, covering Level 4 to Level 7 qualifications - HNCs, HNDs, Foundation Degrees, Higher-Level Apprenticeships and BA Honours - working in partnership with the University of Central Lancashire, the University of Cumbria and other Professional Institutions.

Full-Time Professional & Technical Courses

Our full-time courses offer a mixture of academic & practical learning, great if you have a general career area in mind or are looking to retrain! Studied 3-5 days per week over one or two years, these courses can lead to university, apprenticeships and employment.

Adult Bursary Funds & Advanced Learner Loans are available to support the costs of coming to college e.g. for fees, transport, childcare, trips etc.

The majority of students on these courses are 16-18 year olds, but the college is an adult environment and students of all ages join these courses to retrain.

Part-Time Professional & Leisure Courses

We are committed to offering a wide range of quality courses and training for the local community.

Learn professional skills for your future career or have fun trying something new! A variety of courses, from Accounting to Barbering and Film Making to Furniture Restoration can be studied.

There is also financial support & an Adult Bursary Fund available, so you could study for free!

The majority of students on these courses are adult students, combining study with work, family life and/or other commitments.



Understanding Levels

Level 1 to Level 2 courses give a good foundation for study. Level 3 is at the same level as studying A-Levels. Level 4 and above is higher and degree-level study.

Help With Your Studies

Can I Study For Free?

You may qualify for financial support to cover the cost of a government funded qualification up to and including Level 2, if you:

- Receive an eligible means-tested benefit e.g. JSA, ESA or Universal Credit
- Have an annual salary of less than £17,004
- Are aged 16-18 on 31/08/20 and are not studying at another school/college
- Are aged 19-23 on 31/08/20 and do not already have a Level 1 or 2 qualification
- Have a household income under £25,000 and are in financial hardship

You may qualify for financial support to cover the cost of a Level 3 qualification if you are aged 19-23 on 31/08/20 and do not already have a Level 3 qualification.

Advanced Learner Loans provide financial support towards tuition costs for learners aged 19+ studying a Level 3 or higher qualification. The loan is similar to those available for Higher Education students; repayments do not start until you have completed the course and are earning at least £26,575. Pensions are not counted as income and repayments automatically stop if, for any reason, your salary drops below £26,575.

There is also financial support available to help with the costs of education. For example, childcare, transport, equipment, trips, etc.

What Are The Payment Options?

We accept cash, cards and cheques (made payable to 'Kendal College'). If your course fees are more than £200 and the course runs for 15 weeks or more, you can pay in instalments. A percentage of the course fee will need to be paid at enrolment and you will need to complete a direct debit form at Student Services before you start the course.

Student Discounts

Having those successes behind me, and having reflected further, I’ve now settled on fine art photography as my vocation. There is no guarantee that I’ll make a living from it, but my continuing discovery of the creativity unlocked by the course is rewarding beyond measure.
